To Whom It May Concern:

The Northern Southeast Regional Aquaculture Association (NSRAA) is offering three scholarships, each in the amount of \$2,500. In order to be eligible to apply for the NSRAA scholarship, students must hold a current State of Alaska Southeast Salmon Limited Entry Permit and paid Salmon Enhancement Tax in the Northern Southeast region the year prior to application, or must be a dependent child or other immediate family member of a permit holder as described above. Regular Full-Time, Regular Seasonal and Temporary employees of NSRAA, their dependent children and other immediate family members are also eligible to apply.
