NSRAA Request for Proposals 2021 Season Hidden Falls and Gunnuk Creek Chum Salmon

Dear Interested Salmon Buyers:

The Northern Southeast Regional Aquaculture Association (NSRAA) based in Sitka, Alaska is seeking proposals for the licensing right to harvest chum Salmon at the Hidden Falls and Gunnuk Creek Special Harvest Area's (SHA) for the 2021 season. This harvest is a defined portion of the summer run Hidden Falls stock chum salmon in excess of brood stock needs for each facility. The brood stock chum returns to each facilities SHA will be managed by, at a minimum, weekly fishing effort by one seine vessel. The projected brood stock needs, projected volume of fish available for harvest and projected weekly return timing for each facility is attached.

NSRAA is issuing this RFP as the forecasted return to Hidden Falls hatchery (286,000) is lower than 2020 when egg take goals were not achieved due to a shortfall in brood stock. Managing for brood stock needs (150,000) with a controlled cost recovery effort will allow NSRAA to collect valuable age, sex and otolith information on a weekly basis to evaluate run strength and numbers to the THA. Additionally, this is the first projected significant return to Gunnuk Creek Hatchery (77,000). NSRAA has determined that any chum surplus to brood stock needs (20,000) returning to the Gunnuk Creek Hatchery SHA will be harvested by cost recovery effort, to minimize disruption to the community of Kake. There will be no common property harvest.

Bid Criteria

This a single year bid for NSRAA Hidden Falls and Gunnuk Creek chum salmon. Harvest days, areas and volumes will be determined by NSRAA (licensor), in consultation with the winning processor, as necessary to assure adequate brood stock goals are met at both facilities. A cap of \$500,000 of cost recovery value will be in place for the chum salmon harvested in the Hidden Falls SHA. There is no cap in the Gunnuk Creek SHA and processor will be responsible to harvest all chum salmon in excess of brood stock needs. Actual terminal harvest could be considerably more or less than projected return numbers. Winning processor will need to sign a NSRAA licensing agreement for the cost recovery harvest.

The cost recovery harvest plan for each facility is listed below:

Hidden Falls

For 2021 NSRAA is proposing to manage the early portion of the Hidden Falls chum return via weekly test fishing of up to 50,000lbs. There will be no scheduled common property openings in the THA for chum until brood stock needs are determined to be in the THA by NSRAA or a cap of \$500,000 of cost recovery value has been reached. Once, either the brood stock needs have been determined to be available by NSRAA, or \$500,000 of value has been reached, the chum return will be managed by common property harvest to the greatest extent manageable.

Weekly fishing, beginning stat week 26, will be limited to 50,000 lbs unless otherwise authorized prior to harvest by NSRAA. The weekly fishing will, at a minimum, consist of 5 test sets at the following locations: North line (South Pt), Cosmos, North Pt, Waterfall Cove and Pt Turbot. Additional sets based upon volumes of fish observed in other areas may be authorized after consultation with the NSRAA Cost Recovery manager. Kasnyku Bay will remain off-limits for cost recovery unless specifically opened for Harvest by NSRAA. Chart with set locations and closed area of Kasnyku Bay attached as figure 1.

NSRAA staff will work with the successful bidding processor and seine vessel to assure sampling of catch can occur as needed. This may require the seine vessel crew to assist in marking a small number of the fish caught at each test set location with flagging and/or color coded jaw tags. NSRAA will provide staff on the initial weekly fishing event to instruct the vessel crew on how to segregate and mark catch for future sampling. NSRAA will work with the winning processor to assure the catch is kept separate from any other cost recovery fishing to maintain integrity of the sampling effort. If the winning processor is located outside of Sitka, NSRAA will work with the processor to make available the catch for sampling. This may involve the vessel being sampled at Hidden Falls Hatchery on the grounds or prior to departure. NSRAA will request heads be retained from the test fishing marked chum (up to 96 per week) and coordinate collection and transport to NSRAA's Sitka Office/Lab for processing.

Gunnuk Creek

Cost recovery at Gunnuk Creek will be used to manage the return to meet brood stock needs and harvest all additional return for cost recovery. There is no value cap on the return to Gunnuk Creek and all available fish in excess of brood stock needs will need to be harvested under the direction of the NSRAA Cost Recovery manager. As this is the first significant chum return to Gunnuk Creek Hatchery under the management of NSRAA it will be a learning process for all involved.

As at Hidden Falls, a minimum of weekly effort is anticipated. Due to the smaller return forecast, the initial effort will likely not occur until stat week 27 or until directed by NSRAA. Early portions of the cost recovery effort will be limited by NSRAA to assure

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20,000 brood stock fish are available. Once brood stock is assured, additional effort over weekly fishing will likely be needed to clean up surplus fish. As at Hidden Falls, NSRAA is requesting this catch be segregated from other cost recovery efforts to allow critical run information to be gathered. There will be no set fishing locations in the SHA but NSRAA will work with the seine vessel to harvest the fish in the most efficient means possible while minimizing negative impacts experienced by the community of Kake.






Figure 6. Gunnuk Creek Hatchery SHAs. Note; cost recovery fishing will only occur in the Gunnuk Creek SHA. Southeast Cove SHA will open for common propery harvest.
